Students are encouraged to check their grade regularly and ask questions they might have about their grades. **Do not wait until the end of the semester to do this!**

Absences/Tardy Policy

If a student misses a test or quiz, they must make it up the first day that they return to school online. According to the handbook, students with unexcused absences will be given a zero on any classwork they have missed. In order for an absence to be excused, a parent must email the homeroom teacher notifying the absence. Homework can still be turned in for credit.

Students have 5 minutes to change in between each class. Once class has begun, students will be considered tardy. It is the student's responsibility to come to class on time – and they can't learn if they're not in class!

Retake Policy

All students that score below a 90% on a test or a quiz will be eligible for a retake. Students may only choose **two** retakes per semester. The highest a student can receive on any retake is a 90%.

Content

6th Grade: Earth Science

- Natural resources and how they impact Earth.
